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The International Competition for Chamber Music with Guitar will take place in the city of Braga, Portugal, on  $4^{th}$  and  $5^{th}$  March, 2017, as part of the IV Guitar Festival programme in Braga.

It is open to all chamber music ensembles which include at least one guitar. As chamber music ensembles with guitar can be very diverse, the juries will consider the role and musical relevance of the guitar(s) within each of the competing ensembles when making decisions.

Competing ensembles should essentially perform a repertoire of classical music and each instrument must play its own independent voice (one instrument/score voice).
